Lorne Genome Mid-Career Women in Science Award: \$1000 Sponsored by Illumina

Criteria includes:

- Abstract Submitted through the online abstract portal with applicant first (presenting author).
- 2 page CV outlining recent publications, funding, awards, supervision ect.
- 1 page summary of the applicants work and its impact including national and international standing.
- Open to women up to 10 years EFT post PhD (allowing for career disruptions).

Winner will be selected from applications and will receive a platform presentation and a cash prize.

Lorne Genome Mid-Career Science Award: \$1000 Sponsored by Millennium Science.

Criteria includes:

- Abstract Submitted through the online abstract portal with applicant first (presenting author).
- 2 page CV outlining recent publications, funding, awards, supervision ect.
- 1 page summary of the applicants work and its impact including national and international standing.
- Open to any applicant up to 10 years EFT post PhD (allowing for career disruptions).

Winner will be selected from applications and will receive a platform presentation and a cash prize.

Student Travel Award

Criteria includes:

- Open to anyone enrolled in undergraduate or postgraduate degree.

Recipients will be selected from submitted abstracts and supervisor statements and will receive funds towards travel costs. Preference will be given to students with a clear need for financial support.
